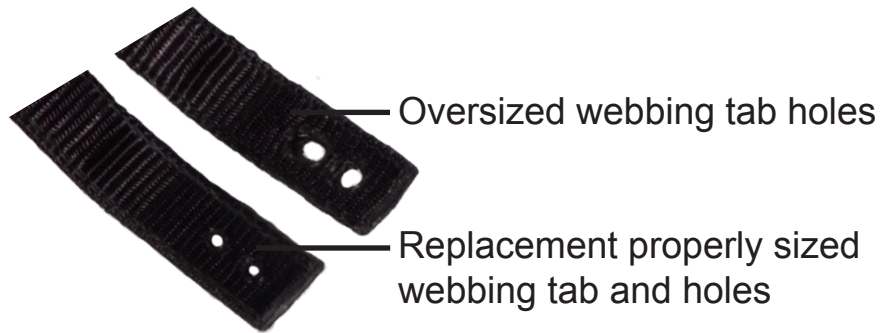
If you've experienced an unintentional release of your 2010 chicken loop you may need to replace the release tab.

Early production versions of the tab were made with bolt hole openings that were too large and which allowed the tab to slide out of place, making unintentional release of the chicken loop possible.

Replacement tabs feature much tighter openings and a stiffer fibreglass spar.

Required Tools

A philips head screwdriver



Changing the tab

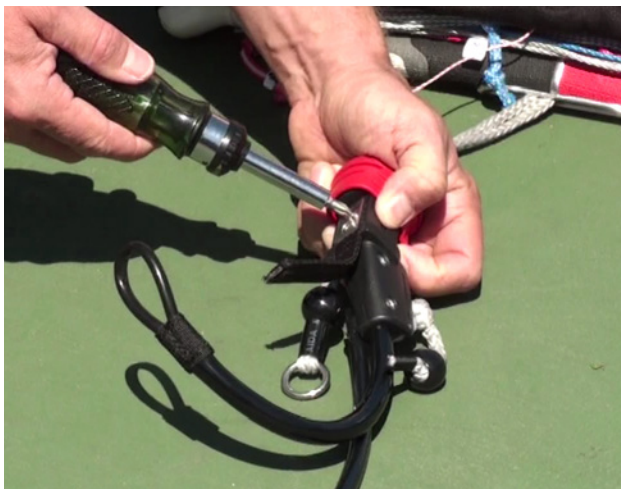
Pull back the red release cuff.



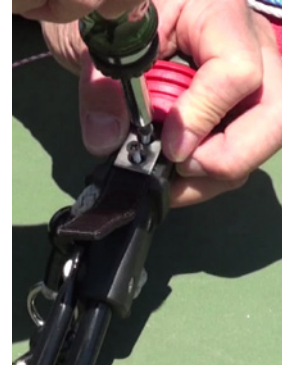
Open the webbing tab and pull back the trim loop.



Unscrew the washer plate to release the webbing tab.



Align the new webbing tab and the existing washer plate to the holes on the release tab. Screw in place.



Slide the red release cuff down over the screw heads. Loop the webbing tab through the trim loop and secure it under the release cuff.



NOTE:

The new webbing tab will be stiff and difficult to close until it is properly loaded once. Force the tab into place and heavily load the chicken loop to properly seat the tab.
